Students

Design a poster of an economic concept included in the Virginia Standards of Learning appropriate for your grade level.

Winners

Eight state winners will each receive a Virginia529 inVEST(inVEST) account with an initial \$100 balance, made possible by Virginia529 College Savings Plan. A 529 plan is a tax-advantaged investment plan designed to encourage saving for future qualified higher education expenses. Art will be posted on VCEE's web site www.vcee.org.

Requirements

- Contest open to elementary and middle school students.
- Entries must be original artwork.
- Use 8 1/2 X 11 paper in horizontal format leave a 1/2 inch margin around the paper. Pictures should be in color with black lettering and all images outlined with a black felt tip marker.
- The economic concept should be written in large letters on the poster.
- Students may illustrate any economic concept that is included in the SOLs appropriate for their grade level.
- No brand names or trademarks may be used.
- Do not fold entries. All spelling must be correct.
- Do not include student's name on the front of the drawing, instead, on the back of each entry, use tape to attach the following information on a 3x5 card: student's name, home address, teacher's name, grade, school, and school division.
- Economic concepts can be reflected in a present day setting or in an historical setting.
